



KAY COOPER MEMORIAL CIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

PURPOSE:

Each year the Kay Cooper Memorial CIC Scholarship is presented at the NAIW Annual State Convention. It is awarded to a qualified member of NAIW to encourage professional development. The scholarship waives the registration fee for the recipient to attend each of the five CIC Institutes in Florida once over an 18-month period.

HISTORY:

Kay Cooper, CIC, CPIW, was an active member of NAIW in Florida and a strong advocate of continuing education, professional development and the CIC program. Kay passed away in 1986, but before she died, her hard work, determination and professionalism made her a great example for others in the insurance industry.

In 1988 the Kay Cooper Scholarship was established as an annual award by the Professional Insurance Agents of Florida with the cooperation of the NAIW and the Society of CIC to help others pursue their professional goals.

ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates for the scholarship must:

1. Be a current member of NAIW;
2. Have never attended a CIC institute;
3. Have been active in the insurance industry for at least two years (however, a license is not required);
4. Be currently employed in the insurance industry or in insurance education;
5. Have shown a commitment to continuing education and professional development.

APPLICATION:

Scholarship candidates should return their applications directly to Professional Insurance Agents of Florida. PIA's Education Committee will then choose the scholarship recipient. We encourage any NAIW member in Florida who meets the eligibility requirements to apply.

Please submit a completed application and any supporting documents to PIA of Florida by August 1, 2008.
